Procedures For The Use Of The Indoor Range

The firing range is closed from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am except for permission of the caretaker.

In order to have use of the indoor range, you must be a member in good standing or the guest of a member and strictly adhere to the following rules.

All Posted range rules must be followed. All members receive a copy when applying for membership. If you are not familiar with them, ask and a copy will be provided.

The wearing of eye protection is required. Hearing protection is strongly recommended. No jacketed ammo is allowed.

If you are using a firearm, turn all switches on the column near the 50-foot bench to the on position, including the exhaust fan switch, to ensure the proper exhaust of powder and lead residue. Don't forget to turn them all off. When finished shooting all brass must be swept from the floor and if not taken home, deposited in the brass receptacle. Please leave the range cleaner than you found it.

Everyone please pay for beverages, whether you are working or not. If you are working, free beverages are available from the bartender or food manager. If there is no bartender there are no free drinks. Please save your club the expense of a coin operated beverage machine by adhering to our honor system.

During the heating season it is extremely important that everyone entering the basement check the boiler water level. If the level drops below a certain point the boiler shuts off. The result may be frozen water pipes. If you are not familiar with this procedure it is your duty to become familiar with it. Please ask someone to show you how to add water to the boiler.

Switch off all lights before leaving. Look at the flood light on the pavilion. If it is on, flip the switch labeled "outside Lights" to the opposite direction.

When ready to leave, please remember to lock the entry door by turning the button located on the inside of the doorknob to the horizontal direction. Close the door and test it to see if it is locked.

Any member observing a violation of these procedures should inform the violator or bring the matter before the Board of Directors.
