

Rules For Ranges

- 1. No alcohol on any of the ranges.**
- 2. Actions on all guns must be open until ready to fire.**
- 3. No persons allowed beyond firing line when range is in use.**
- 4. Muzzles should be pointed down range, except when cased.**
- 5. Eye protection must be worn on all ranges.**
- 6. No Jacketed ammunition allowed on indoor Pistol Range.**
- 7. No Steel Jacket or Steel Core Ammo on any range.**
- 8. Shooting to be at paper targets only.**
- 9. Hang targets from horizontal boards only.**
- 10. Hearing protection should be used on all firearms ranges.**
- 11. No handling of firearms except on range.**
- 12. Put paper targets in trash barrels, pick up brass.**
- 13. All muzzleloaders must be uncapped until ready to shoot.**
- 14. No one under 15 allowed to shoot on range without adult supervision.**
- 15. Membership Credentials needed while on any range.**
- 16. Trap Shooters load only one shell at a time “when its your turn” The only exception is when shooting doubles.**
- 17. No Broadheads on archery range. Exception, designated targets on left.**
- 18. No shooting on 200-yard range while rest of the ranges are in use.**
- 19. Indoor targets must be rolled all the way down against the backstop.**
- 20. Range officer has full authority to enforce these rules.**
- 21. Members observing violations of these rules should inform violator.**
- 22. Violation of these rules may result in termination of club membership.**
